Wiggins to speak at Expo

Coastal Angler show fun for kids

The third annual Coastal Angler Boat Show and Fishing Expo is being held at the Melbourne Auditorium on Friday through Sunday. The show centers on boating, fishing, and conservation education.

Capt. Blair Wiggins, the 2006 FLW Redfish Tournament Champion, host of the national television show "Addictive Fishing" and founder of Blair Wiggins' Professional Fishing Academy, will be one of the keynote speakers, addressing attendees at 2 p.m. Saturday and 2 p.m. Sunday.

Another special attraction is the third annual Hook Kids on Fishing program which will be held around the Melbourne Auditorium lake from 8:45 to 11 a.m. Saturday.

The free program is divided into classes focusing on conservation and safety, tackle and rigging, species recognition and casting techniques and of course, fishing. Each of the first 100 young anglers who pre-register will receive a rod and reel plus a small tackle

box. To register, contact the Melbourne Leisure Services office at 255-4608.

Volunteers are needed to assist the children between the ages of 6 and 16.

Also on the agenda is the Melbourne Seafood Fest, with local dishes prepared by Melbourne's Shells Seafood Restaurant, Denver Kline of Melbourne and Orlando's Fish on Fire, the Marine Resources Council's Lagoon Day and the boat show featuring craft from 10 to more than 30 feet.

Also, a wide array of vendors will be on hand.
